Applicant Criteria

- Must be an enrolled member of the Fort Belknap Indian Community
- Attending an accredited higher education institution in the United States
- Must be enrolled full-time (Full-time status may vary depending on higher education institution and/or area of study)

Scholarship available through the ANCF Scholarship Fund

• ANCF Undergraduate & Graduate Scholarship: Scholarships are for \$2,000 for the full academic year.

(Does not include Summer semester)

Essay Questions (Double spaced, typed, 12 pt. font only)

The application requires essay questions that are listed below. This is an opportunity to tell your story and demonstrate your writing skills. Answer the following questions in a separate document and include the question in each essay answer:

- ✓ Introduction Introduce yourself in the Aaniiih or Nakoda language (<u>not mandatory</u>) and in English. Include information about your family and community. (minimum of 100 words)
- ✓ Why do you want to pursue higher learning? (minimum of 150 words)
- ✓ What do you expect to gain from earning a degree or certificate? (minimum 150 words)
- ✓ Describe a personal challenge(s) you have faced in your life? How did you overcome this challenge? (Minimum of 300 words)
- ✓ What is your vision for the future? How will the ANCF Scholarship help you attain your goals? (minimum 200 words)
