The Aaniiih Nakoda Community Foundation (ANCF) Scholarship Fund was established to support educational opportunities for the Aaniiih (Gros-Ventre) and Nakoda (Assiniboine) People of the Fort Belknap Indian Reservation. The ANCF's mission is aligned with Island Mountain Development Group's mission which is dedicated to creating a self-sustaining economy by striving to create opportunities for the Aaniiih and Nakoda Nations through business, jobs, and resource development. ANCF recognizes that in order to do so, we must invest in our future leaders. Our scholarship grant fund is one way we can accomplish that and promote our values of generosity, sustainability, and resilience.

Applicant Criteria

- Must be an enrolled member of the Fort Belknap Indian Community and provide proof
- Attending an Accredited higher education institution in the United States (website listed)
- Must be enrolled <u>Undergraduate full-time</u> (Full-time status may vary depending on higher education institution and/or area of study) (Levels above undergraduate bachelor's degree are ineligible)
- Must have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 (not term GPA)
- · Previous scholarship recipients must have turned in final grades for previous award

• ANCF Undergraduate Scholarship: Scholarship grants are for the full academic year.

- 4. What is your vision for the future? How will the ANCF Scholarship help you reach your goals?
